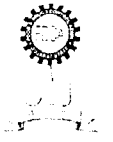

With reference to above cited subject and reffered letter this is to inform you that the Indian Pharmacopoeia Commision (IPC), an autonomus institution of Ministry Of Health And Family Welfare, Government of India, functions as the National Coordination Center (NCC) for the Materiovigilance Programme of India (MvPI) since January 2018.

The MvPI works with an objective to ensure patient/user/third party saftey by monitoring, recording, analyzing root cause of adverse events or risks associated with use of medical devices in indian population and suggests evidane-based inputs to the Regulatory Authority to take appropriate regulatory action.

In view of the above, you are requested to initiate the step for strengthening public health by sensitizing and advising all the doctoras and other healthcare professionals under your jurisdiction to adopt reporting of medical devices adverse event to MvPI-IPC.
